LOCAL WOMAN ARRESTED AFTER SEARCH WARRANT

On Monday April 16, 2012, at approximately 9:48 p.m. officers from the Coalinga Police Department served a narcotic search warrant in the 200 block of E. Pleasant Street. Officers contacted and detained two occupants of the home in the front yard as they arrived.

Officers then cleared the home for any additional subjects and found an elderly male sleeping in one of the bedrooms. One of the detained subjects told the officers they could call (text) the other occupant of the home to return. A few minutes later 41 year old Coalinga resident Janelle Story was observed walking back to the house and she was immediately detained.

Story became aggressively combative to officers at which time she was transported to the Coalinga Police Department. During the search of the home several narcotic items were located and seized by officers. A methamphetamine pipe was located in Story's bedroom.

Story was arrested for misdemeanor charges of Possession of marijuana, Possession of unlawful paraphernalia and Destroy/conceal of evidence. Story was later released on a citation to appear in court.
