Felon Caught With A Concealed Weapon and Stolen Check Out of Hanford

While conducting a patrol check in the area of the Coalinga Library, Coalinga Police Officer Saucedo made contact with a suspicious person in the alley way.

Jason McBurnie, a 26 year old convicted felon, was contacted and found to be in possession of a concealed knife and was taken in to custody without incident.

While doing an inventory of McBurnie's property he was found to have a large amount of unprinted business checks, from a business in Hanford, in his backpack. The business was contacted and advised that they had reported those checks stolen a week ago and named Jason McBurnie as the suspect.

McBurnie was seen on video removing those checks from the business office of that business.

Detectives with the Kings County Sherriff's Department responded to Coalinga to interview McBurnie and arranged for him to be transported to Kings County to be booked into their facility after he was booked into the Coalinga city jail for charges of carried a concealed weapon and possession of stolen property.
