FOUR ARRESTED AFTER TRAFFIC STOP

On Friday September 7, 2012, at approximately 10:15 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Buchanan Street, on the report of someone seeing two male subjects with guns. Officers responded to the area and located a black Honda leaving the area.

Officers conducted an investigative stop and contacted 22 year old Coalinga Resident Rogelio Luna, 18 year old Huron Resident Felix Luna, 20 year old Huron Resident Fernando Sosa and 18 year old Huron Resident Jairo Madrigal.

Officers detained the four subjects and searched the vehicle. Upon searching the vehicle, officers located a loaded .38 caliber revolver and a loaded .45 caliber handgun inside the car. All four subjects were arrested and transported to the Coalinga City Jail where they were booked on charges of Exhibit a firearm; Carry a loaded firearm in a public place, Assault with a deadly weapon and participating in criminal street gang. The four subjects are documented Norteno gang members and were later transported to the Fresno County Jail. It appears the four subjects were preparing to retaliate for a shooting that occurred earlier in the morning.
