FOUR ARRESTED AND THREE GUNS RECOVERED

On Tuesday October 2, 2012 at approximately 8:30 a.m. officers from the Coalinga Police Department and with the assistance of the Huron Police Department served a search warrant in the 1500 block of Tornado Street in the City of Huron.

Officers were there searching for weapons possible being stored at the home and surrounding out buildings that have been used in recent shootings between the two cities. On officers arrival they deployed diversionary devices and made entry into the home and out buildings where they detained four subjects.

Upon searching the residence and out buildings, officers located a .22 caliber revolver, a shotgun, a .22 automatic assault type pistol with high capacity magazines, ammunition and a methamphetamine pipe. Arrested at the scene was 62 year old Huron resident Jerry Hernandez, 19 year old Huron resident Jose Alvarado, 19 year old Huron resident Yoana Delgadillo and 31 year old Huron resident Hope Ojeda. Hernandez was arrested for possession of a methamphetamines pipe, Alvarado and Delgadillo were arrested for gang members being in possession of a firearm and Ojeda was arrested for an out of county warrant.

All four subjects were transported to the Coalinga Police Department where they were booked and held pending transport to the Fresno County Jail.
