**WINDOW SMASH LEADS TO BURGLARY ARREST**

On May 25, 2013, at about 2:05 a.m., Coalinga Police personnel were dispatched to the Cricket Store, 220 W Polk St., on a citizen's report of a subject breaking in.

Chief Minor, along with Officers Forlines and Munoz responded to the scene where they contacted 24-year-old Coalinga resident Victor Fontaine coming out of the store. Fontaine was taken into custody without incident.

Fontaine had allegedly broken the glass on the door of the store to gain entry. Fontaine was found to be in possession of a bag containing approximately 80 cellular phones that were stolen from the store.

Fontaine was booked at the Coalinga Police Department for Commercial Burglary and then transferred to the Fresno County Jail.

All suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
