

INVESTIGATION LEADS TO ARREST

On Monday December 9, 2013 officer responded to a local business on the reports of fraudulent checks. On Sunday December 15, 2013 officer's responded back to the same business on the report of fraudulent checks being used again. The checks used belonged to a victim of vehicle burglary that occurred on November 29, 2013 in the 200 block of McCollum Lane in which the victim's checks, debit card and personal documents were stolen.

Further investigation into this case by patrol officers lead them to conduct a probation search in the 100 block of Tyler Street. Contacted at the home was 27 year old Coalinga resident Serenity Young and 36 year old Coalinga resident Jason Morris. During the search items were located in their possession which linked them to vehicle burglary and to the theft of FedEx packages that were reported stolen to the police department on December 13, 2013.

Both subjects were arrested on multiple felony charges. They were transported to the Coalinga City Jail and were later transported to the Fresno County Jail.
