**“Search Warrant Leads to Five Arrests and the Recovery of Weapons, Ammunition, Narcotics and Drug Paraphernalia”**

On February 19, 2014, at approximately 3:20 pm, Coalinga Police executed a narcotics search warrant in the 300 block of East Houston Street in Coalinga.

Officers contacted 42 year old Monica Fallorina, 44 year old Michelle Lund, 42 year old Christina Evans, 22 year old Cedric Pena, as well as a 17 year old minor. All are Coalinga residents.

The search warrant led to the recovery of methamphetamine, marijuana, drug paraphernalia, illegal weapons and ammunition.

Fallorina, Lund, Evans and Pena were arrested on various charges including, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, weapons charges, possession of ammunition by a convicted felon, and on active arrest warrants out of Fresno County. The 17 year old minor was also arrested for possession of marijuana, possession of a concealed weapon, an active arrest warrant issued out of Fresno County and for violating the terms of his Fresno County probation.

The above persons were booked into the Fresno County main jail. The minor, whose name will remain confidential due to his age, was booked into the Fresno County Juvenile Justice Campus.
