"Follow up leads to multiple arrests"

On May 31, 2014 Officers were called to the area of Fresno and Tyler street on a report of a physical assault. Officer George Munoz responded to the scene and took the report.

The victim, a 16 year old minor, explained to the officers he was assaulted by a man who was driving recklessly in a Black Ford Bronco. The victim said he had words with them over the way they were driving in the neighborhood. The Bronco stopped and the man got out and punched the 16 year old in the face, got back in the Bronco and drove away. The unique thing about the Bronco was that it was lifted and did not have its top on.

Awhile later, Officer Munoz, spotted the unique Black Bronco and completed an Investigative stop. The occupants, a man and a woman matching the description given by the victim, were inside the Bronco at the time of the stop. The man, Nicholas Deleon, was a passenger and found to be a wanted "Parolee at Large" (PAL) out of Fresno. He was placed under arrest for his felony warrant out of Fresno. The female driver, Jennifer Jenkins, was also placed under arrest. She was found to have an outstanding misdemeanor warrant out of Fresno. After completing a series of sobriety test on the female driver, Officer Munoz added a fresh charge of suspicion of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

The original assault charge is still being investigated, and charges will be filed with the Fresno County District Attorney's Office against both Nicholas Deleon, and Jennifer Jenkins. They were booked into the Coalinga City Jail, and later transferred to Fresno County Jail.
