"Search Warrant Leads to Arrest and the Recovery of Narcotics, Manufacturing Equipment, and Weapon"

On June 8, 2014, at approximately 6:38 pm, Coalinga Police Officers executed a search warrant in the 100 block of East Cedar Street related to narcotics manufacturing, and sales.

A search of the home led to the recovery of honey oil, marijuana, manufacturing equipment, packaging materials and indicia of narcotics sales. Officers were also able to recover ammunition and a snub nose Smith and Wesson .38 caliber revolver that had its serial number filed off.

At the scene, Officers arrested 23 year old Coalinga resident Kris Nestor Ayala. The investigation is continuing into the involvement of others who are known to live in and frequent the home.

The recovered firearm is pending further processing and testing by the California Department of Justice to ascertain if the firearm is stolen and if it has been linked or used in other crimes.

Ayala was processed at the Coalinga Police Department and booked into the Fresno County Main Jail on various charges including, manufacturing honey oil, possession of a controlled substance, possession of a controlled substance for sales, illegal possession of a firearm, and possession of a firearm with an altered serial number.
