Coalinga Police Department investigating a Saturday morning shooting

On January 9, 2016, at approximately 2 am, Officers responded to an apartment complex located in the 500 block of East Glenn Avenue on a report of multiple people who had been shot. Upon arrival, officers located three people who had been the victims of gunshots while attending a house party. Preliminary information from witnesses revealed that during the gathering, witnesses heard glass breaking to the apartment where the party was occurring. As patrons exited the apartment to see what was happening, they were shot at by two unidentified males wearing dark colored clothing. The three victims struck by gunfire were transported by ambulance to Community Regional Medical Center in Fresno with non life threatening injuries.

The shooting appear to be gang related and the investigation is continuing.
