“Case Updates- Convictions and Prison Time for Coalinga Arrestees”

This press release concerns prior criminal investigations conducted by the Coalinga Police Department, which have resulted in plea agreements requiring prison time.

On March 14, 2013, members of the Coalinga Police Department executed a narcotics search warrant in the 300 block of Monroe Street. The search warrant led to the arrest of 53 year old Coalinga resident Robert Murillo for various drug and weapons related charges. Since his arrest, Murillo has agreed to a plea agreement of a five year sentence. Murillo is currently in custody pending his formal sentencing in July of 2014.

On March 7, 2014, members of the Coalinga Police Department investigated a shooting that occurred in the 100 block of Walnut Street. Investigators learned that shots were fired at a pedestrian in the area from a moving vehicle. The investigation led to the arrest of 19 year old Adolfo Zermeno, and two 17 year old juveniles, all from Huron. On June 24, 2014, the three involved suspects accepted plea agreements that include a seven years prison sentence and one felony strike. They will not be credited for time served since their arrest. The three are due to be formally sentenced in July of 2014.
