



Summary of Ordinance No. 868 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COALINGA AMENDING THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE RELATED TO VEHICLE WASHING FACILITIES, GYMNASIUMS, AND DRIVE-THROUGHS.

This is a summary of Ordinance No. 868, which was approved at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Coalinga on September 19, 2024.

Ordinance No 868, amends the planning and zoning code regulations related to vehicle washing facilities, gymnasiums, and drive-through prohibitions. The ordinance updates the planning and zoning code to amend the following regulation in the code:

Gymnasiums: Update definitions of a gym and fitness center including allowing this use in the Manufacturing/Business Light (MBL) zoning designation with additional criteria limiting outdoor activities during certain hours.

Vehicle Washing Facilities: Amending the vehicle washing facilities into two categories selfserve/automated vs. hand washing and detail services (including tenting). In addition, Council wishes to permit handwashing and detail facilities as permitted by-right in commercial zones subject to listed local and state regulations.

Drive-Through Facilities: Council wishes to remove the prohibitions on drive-through facilities in the General Commercial (CG) zoning district which is currently prohibited.

Effective Date: The ordinance will become effective October 18, 2024.
